


Check Availability: Visit **Namecheap** and use their search bar to check if your desired domain name is available. If it's taken, try different variations or come up with new ideas.


Tip: write the login details on a piece of paper that you keep in a safe place to access it when is needed.

After purchasing your domain, log in to your Namecheap account and navigate to the "Dashboard."




Find Your Domain:

Set Up Redirect: In the "Domain" tab, scroll down to the "Redirect Domain" section. Here, you can set up a redirect.

- a. Source URL: Enter your new domain name (e.g., (yourdomain .com).
- b. Destination URL: Enter your LiveGood affiliate link.

Step 2: Go to Drop Menu and choose "My Websites"

Step 3: Copy any link you desire (Powerline Landing Page recommended) and paste it into the Namecheap redirection section.

Just set a SOURCE CODE and track your results!

When posting or emailing out the link to your LiveGood website (https://www.LiveGoodTour.com/yourusername), all you need to do is add the following set of characters to the end of your link and you will know where each of your leads is coming from:

?SOURCE=yoursourcecode

So if you were using an autoresponder called ABC for example and you wanted to set your source code to know which leads came from that autoresponder, you can simply add that to your URL.

So your new link would be:

https://www.LiveGoodTour.com/yourusernameSOURCE=abc

Add a little bit of body text.

Just replace the code "ABC" with whatever you want your source code to be. You can use as many different source codes as you desire, and all of those statistics will be tracked RIGHT HERE!

Save Changes:

After entering the details, click "Save All Changes." This will ensure that anyone who visits your domain will be redirected to your LiveGood affiliate link.

Test Your Domain:

Finally, test your new domain by typing it into your browser (try Incognito mode) to ensure it correctly redirects to your LiveGood affiliate link.

Keep It Short and Simple: Shorter names are easier to remember and type.

Avoid Numbers and Hyphens: These can be confusing and are often mistyped.

Be Unique: Ensure your domain stands out and represents your brand effectively.
